Rules and Conditions

1. Entry Fees are non-refundable.
2. The Organisers do not accept liability for any accident, loss, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, ground, spectators or any other person or property.
3. Appropriate footwear & hard hats with fastened chinstraps that comply with BS PAS 015, BS EN 1384 or ASTM F116395 (as per British Horse Society guidelines) must be worn at all times.
4. The Organisers recommend that Body Protectors should also be worn by all riders.
5. The Organisers reserve the right to retire any horse or pony that appears to be in any way distressed or unfit.
6. Riders under 14 must be accompanied by an adult.
7. No horses or ponies under 4 years old.
8. Flu-vac is recommended within six months of the ride.
9. Competitors **must** keep on the marked route of the ride and show consideration to other riders.
PLEASE DO NOT OVERTAKE OTHER RIDERS WITHOUT ASKING IF IT IS ALRIGHT TO DO SO, AND PLEASE SLOW DOWN TO AN APPROPRIATE PACE WHEN PASSING.
10. Each Entrant is responsible for collecting amounts promised to them and for paying them to the Organisers in a timely manner.
11. Any St. John's Ambulance, Blacksmith or Veterinary Fee will be the responsibility of the rider or horse owner.
12. It is recommended that riders should take out accident insurance for themselves and their horse.
13. It is *forbidden* for any rider to *walk* on the Al Bahathri gallop – please use the grass at the side if you do not wish to gallop. (20 mile ride only)
PLEASE DO NOT GO ON ANY OTHER GALLOPS

Fees, rules and conditions remain the same for all courses

- The organisers cannot be held responsible for entrants missing their ride time due to transport failure. The course can only remain open to riders starting between 10am-12.30pm on the day due to the road crossings being manned solely by volunteers
- Prizes will be awarded to the highest sponsorship raised in each of three categories: Junior Team/Individual (under 16 years of age), Senior Team and Senior Individual
- All cheques should be made payable to **MACMILLAN**. Riders who fail to pay their sponsor money one year will be required to pay the minimum £20 on the day of the ride in future.
